Leslie H. Wexner, Founder of Limited Brands, started the company in Columbus, Ohio in 1963 with one store and first year sales of \$160,000.

Today, Mr. Wexner serves as Chairman of Limited Brands, which operates over 3,970 stores including Express, Victoria's Secret, Bath & Body Works, The Limited, The White Barn Candle Co., Henri Bendel and aura science. Sales for Limited Brands were \$8.5 billion in 2002.

Mr. Wexner is a Member of the Visiting Committee of the Graduate School of Design, Harvard University; a Trustee, The Aspen Institute; Trustee of the Columbus Jewish Federation and Foundation; and Chairman Emeritus, The Ohio State University Board of Trustees.

Mr. Wexner has a profound interest in the development of tomorrow's leaders through the works of the Wexner Foundation; the Wexner Heritage Foundation; the Wexner Israel Fellowship Program at Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government; and the Fisher College of Business at The Ohio State University.

His areas of philanthropic interest include the Wexner Center for the Arts at The Ohio State University; the Wexner Institute for Pediatric Research at Children's Hospital, Columbus; the Martin Luther King Center for the Performing Arts, Columbus; and the Wexner Heritage Village. Mr. Wexner was a recipient of The Alexis de Tocqueville Society Award of the United Way of America. He was a founding member and the first chair of The Ohio State University Foundation.

Mr. Wexner has a B.S. degree in Business Administration from The Ohio State University, and holds honorary degrees from The Ohio State University; The Hebrew University of Jerusalem; Hofstra University; Marietta College; Hebrew Union College; The Jewish Theological Seminary of America; Yeshiva University; and Brandeis University. Mr. Wexner was inaugurated by Harvard University into the Society of John Harvard Fellows.

Mr. Wexner and his wife, Abigail, are the parents of four children.
