### **Bio- Founder and President, Cheryl Milone**

Cheryl Milone, Esq., B.S.E.E., is the founder and president of Article One Partners, a new global online community that legitimizes the validity of patents. A leading authority on patent applications, Ms. Milone has advocated before the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office to procure patent rights. Earlier in her career, Lucent’s Advanced Micro-Technology Group requested that she replace six other outside counsels. Ms. Milone held positions counseling on intellectual property rights at Roger & Wells, L.L.P. and Kenyon & Kenyon, L.L.P. She has also implemented her in-depth knowledge of prior art in her work as a patent counsel and sales officer for a patent research company from 2000 to 2001.
