

JENNIFER R. BERMAN, M.D.

Jennifer R. Berman is a practicing urologist and internationally renowned expert and pioneer in the field of female sexual and menopausal health. She is among the few female urologists in the United States. A co-founder of the Female Sexual Medicine Center at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), she serves as director of female urology and sexual medicine at the Rodeo Drive Women's Health Center in Beverly Hills, Calif.



Berman has appeared on national television, in print and on radio including on "Good Morning America," "The Oprah Winfrey Show," CNN's "Larry King Live," CBS's "48 Hours," "The NBC Nightly News," and on programming on MSNBC, Lifetime Television, and America's Health Network, among others. She co-hosted with her sister Laura Berman, Ph.D., Discovery Health Network's daily talk and magazine show, "Berman and Berman: For Women Only."

She is the author of several books on women's health and numerous publications for peer-reviewed journals and has lectured worldwide. Her significant scientific contributions in the advancement of women's health earned Berman the Pfizer Scholar in Urology Award in two consecutive years and she has received other awards and honors from local to international in scope.

Berman earned her medical degree from the Boston University School of Medicine. She completed her post-graduate urology residency at the University of Maryland and received specialized fellowship training in female urology at UCLA Medical Center. She is a member of the editorial board of several scientific journals and is a fellow of the American Urological Association.

In her personal life, Berman plays an active role in increasing awareness about women's health issues.
