SAVING GRACE

- **Final Six Episodes begin Monday, May 24, at 10 p.m. (ET/PT)**

Three years ago, TNT brought viewers one of the most unique drama series on television. This summer, the extraordinary journey will end with the final six episodes. Starring Oscar[®]-winning actress Holly Hunter, SAVING GRACE focuses on gutsy Oklahoma City Police Det.
